

**DESK PANEL PA8/267A****Introduction**

The PA8/267A is an auxiliary panel for use with Type-D sound-control equipment. It carries prompt cut selector keys, group output volume controls and public address changeover keys.

The equipment is mounted in a CH1/37C chassis having overall dimensions of 7 by 6¾ by 10½ inches.

**General Description**

The prompt cut selection keys for the main and six group circuits are illuminated locking pushbutton keys, and they are normally wired in a 'select to bypass' condition. That is to say, when a key is depressed the group prompt cut relay is bypassed and

the circuit cannot be broken. The group relays are wired in series with the main prompt cut relay so that when a group circuit is selected, the main circuit must also be selected.

There are six one-kilohm carbon-track log volume controls for controlling the second output of the group modules.

The panel also carries two three-position locking keys used to switch the odd and even public address chains to the outputs of either of the two public address amplifiers (*A* and *B*).
